Tenure-Track Faculty Position in Dynamics and Control in the Department of Mechanical Engineering at Villanova University

The Department of Mechanical Engineering at Villanova University has an opening for a tenure-track faculty position in the area of dynamics and control. The department has established research strengths in mobile robotics, autonomous systems, machine learning, and nonlinear dynamics and control. Candidates are expected to complement and strengthen existing department research or develop new high-impact research directions.

The primary responsibilities of the successful candidate include developing and sustaining a vibrant research program, collaborating with faculty in the Center for Nonlinear Dynamics and Control (CENDAC) and the Villanova Center for Analytics of Dynamic Systems (VCADS), and teaching and developing undergraduate and graduate courses. Required are a Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering or a closely related field, a proven ability for high quality research, and a demonstrated commitment to teaching excellence and innovation. The position starts in August 2020.

Villanova is a Carnegie-classified doctoral university and the Mechanical Engineering faculty are internationally recognized for their research achievements. The university is located 12 miles from Philadelphia along the historic Main Line. The department has 22 full-time faculty members, approximately 300 undergraduate students, and 150 graduate students (including 40 Ph.D. students). We are committed to providing a rigorous educational experience in the discipline of mechanical engineering, graduating well-rounded leaders and life-long learners, who aspire to achieving professional excellence. We are equally committed to the discovery, dissemination, advancement and application of cutting-edge research.
